ENTRY FEE: The entry fee is \$300 per team (\$150 per gender). Checks must be made out to

"The Trustees of Hamilton College."

STARTING BLOCKS: All student-athletes will be required to use blocks supplied by Hamilton College

SPIKE/SHOE LIMITATIONS: •The only spike types allowed for our facility is ½" pyramid or Christmas Tree

spikes. No pyramids with a sharp point, pins, needles, Steelex Hex Pyramids, or permanent spike shoes (e.g. Asics Japan, Nike Zoom Mawler) will be

permitted.

•This applies to the long jump, triple jump, high jump, and all running events.

Meet officials will enforce this rule. The penalty for this infraction is

disqualification.

SCRATCHES: Please report known scratches prior to the start of the meet.

FACILITIES:

Hamilton Fieldhouse:

- 1. 200m Mondo Track FTX (13mm)
- 6-36" lanes on the oval, 9-42" lanes on the straight.
- 3. Mondo Track FTX surface for Long Jump, Triple Jump, & Pole Vault.
 - •Triple Jump Boards 28' Painted, 32' Tray System, 36' Painted, and 40' Tray System.
- 4. High Jump will be conducted off Mondo FTX interior.
- 5. 9-Olympic style blocks will be provided
- Throwing events will be conducted off and AAE circle with 3/4" thick 6. NuronTM surface; and a synthetic rubber top to allow for minimal friction

LOCKER ROOMS:

Locker rooms are located in the Alumni Gymnasium. Towels and locks are the responsibility of the visiting teams.

IMPLEMENT CERTIFICATION: All implement inspections will take place in the Fieldhouse Storage Room (in back end of fieldhouse) between 9:30 and 10:45 A.M. Only meet certified implements may be used during the championships. All certified implements will be impounded and made available during the allotted warm-up time.

20/35 Lb. WEIGHTS:

Only soft shell bag weights, or those that restrict bounce, may be used at the competition. The meet management has the discretion to withhold any throwing implement that may endanger anyone associated with the orderly and reasonable continuation of the meet.

SEEDING:

Seeding for all events will follow the NCAA rules.

HEAT SHEETS:

Heat sheets will be available after all pre-meet scratches have been processed. .

RULES/SCORING:

NCAA Rules apply. Non-scoring meet.

STARTING HEIGHTS:

HJ - 5'6'' (men) & 4'6'' (women). PV - 10'6'' (men) & 8' (women)

ADVANCEMENT:

In all field and running events requiring prelims, nine athletes will advance to the

final.

Field event clerking will take place at the respective field event venues 20 minutes prior to the start of the event. Track event clerking will take place at the designated clerking table (near 60m starting line) 15 minutes prior to the start of each running event.

DIRECTIONS: •From the East (including NY City): New York State Thruway (I-90)

westbound to the Westmoreland Exit 32. Take 233 South about 5 miles to the foot of College Hill Road (blinking light). Turn right up the hill to the campus.

•From the West: New York State Thruway (I-90) eastbound to Westmoreland

Exit 32. Proceed as "from the east."

• From the South: Rt. 12 northbound from Binghamton to Sherburne. In Sherburne, Rt. 12 bears right. Straight ahead is the beginning of 12B North. Follow 12B through Deansboro. Partway between Deansboro and Clinton, turn left on 233 North, about 1.2 miles to the foot of College Hill Road (blinking

light). Turn left up the hill to the campus.

•*From the North:* Rt. 12 South to Utica/New Hartford. In New Hartford, follow signs for Rt. 12B and Clinton. Follow Rt. 12B to Clinton. At the 2nd traffic light,

go straight ahead onto College Street. Follow College Street to campus.


